

HOUSEBOAT TRIP INFORMATION 2021

Please return your Trip Confirmation ASAP. We must have it **at least 2 weeks prior to your trip** so we can schedule our people. Your turn-around fees are due prior to your trip. Launch times will be given to those with fees paid first.

1. We are again allowing owners to stay on the houseboat in our yard at **612 Haul Road** the night before (at your own risk, of course). The yard will once again be open at 7 pm. Please come in and make yourself at home. TO PROTECT YOURSELF – remember to complete the Good to Go Boarding Checklist located at the front of the boat. Report any discrepancies to the Truck Driver prior to leaving the yard. It is much easier for us to correct issues before leaving the yard than it is to correct them at the time of launch. All owners must complete the Liability Waiver Form prior to entering the yard, so we ask that it be returned with your trip information.
2. We managed to get through the entire season last year without COVID-19 going through our workforce. We want to extend our thanks to all of you for helping us through a season we were not sure could happen. We will again be implementing the same safety protocols that were in place last year in hopes of getting through another season virus free.
3. Just a reminder – the boats are not stocked with mechanic tool kits. We recommend you bring personal tools that you feel comfortable using. To prevent possible liability to yourself and the boat group, do not leave any tools on the boat.
4. If you have lake toy equipment loaded, please report to the Truck Driver any damage you see prior to leaving the yard. Lake toy equipment should be inspected before and after each trip. You will be charged for damages, so make sure it is inspected both before and after your trip. THE PARK SERVICE PROHIBITS US FROM LAUNCHING RENTED PWCs ON THE HOUSEBOATS. IF YOU HAVE RENTED PWCs, YOU MUST HAUL THEM INTO THE PARK YOURSELF SO THEY CAN BE INSPECTED.
5. You will need to take all vehicles to the lake with you. We will have a shuttle at the ramp to help you get up and down the ramp as you park your vehicles. Let the truck driver know you will need a shuttle from the parking lot and he will arrange for it. **You will still be liable for park entrance fees for your party.**
6. Lake Powell is listed as an Aquatic Invasive Species (AIS) body of water. The rules are different depending on where you are transporting your boat to after you leave Lake Powell. EVERYONE will need to remove plugs and drain all water prior to leaving the ramp. 7. **From the Park Service:**
 - **Swimming is not allowed in the marina areas due to safety issues including possible electrocution.**
 - **Drones are not allowed in the Park.**
 - **Fireworks are illegal in the Park.**
 - **Defacing the rock is illegal. Please inform everyone in your party to refrain from writing on the rock and; PLEASE – TAKE ALL YOUR WASTE WHEN YOU LEAVE.**
 - **ALL PIN ANCHORING IS PROHIBITED – Pin anchoring in new or existing holes is prohibited. They are starting a push to eliminate this practice and will be issuing citations.**
8. Your retrieval time is noted on the Good to Go paperwork. The fine for a late return is **\$250 per hour**. With the additional time it takes to sanitize, we need the boats back in our yard and unloaded within 1 hour of your return. Because we will not be checking you off the boat it is especially important that the Work Order be completed so we can make any needed repairs before the next owner boards.
